

# 2026 LHSRA RODEO FINALS at BURTON COMPLEX

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All motorized vehicles (including ATV's, 4-wheelers, and other recreational vehicles) are required to be driven by a licensed driver.
- All small motorized/electric vehicles (hoverboards, scooters, bikes, etc.) are prohibited from property and will be seized.

## ENTRY INTO THE BURTON COLISEUM:

- Bags and Personal Items will be subject to search upon entry and re-entry. Laser pointers and weapons of any kind are prohibited and will be seized.
- No outside food or drink is permitted inside the coliseum. Patrons will be asked to throw these items away in trash receptacles located near entrances before entering the facility.
- Please note: Only ADA recognized service animals are permitted to accompany an adult inside the coliseum. Pets and comfort animals will not be permitted.

- \$12.00 per performance / \$45.00 per 5-performance pass
- Tickets are available for purchase at the Coliseum's East Box Office (same side as the Outdoor Arena) and at the contestant meetings. Tickets can be purchased during the following times:

- A wristband will be given at the time of ticket purchase. Wristbands are required to be worn for the duration of the event for valid entry and re-entry. Any wristband not on a person, cut or taped, will not be valid and a new ticket must be purchased.

- **Your reservation confirmation will be required to receive your vehicle stickers upon check-in at the Camper Site Entry Gate.**
- To ensure public safety, only 2 vehicles per camper will be permitted in the camping area. Any additional vehicles will be required to park in the Complex's main parking lots. Upon check-in, a Burton staff member will place a sticker on the vehicle towing the camper/trailer. These stickers are non-transferable, cannot be removed and must always be visible for the duration of participants' stay. All vehicles without a sticker will not be permitted to be in the camper area.
- No dry camping is allowed. To camp overnight, a campsite must be rented.
- Place all garbage in plastic bags and throw your trash in one of our 5 large Waste Management dumpsters located at the end of each camper site row. Signage has been placed throughout the campsite to assist you in finding their location.

- **Your reservation confirmation will be required to unlock your stalls.**
- Due to the limited number of stalls, contestants are limited to one stall per qualified event that requires a horse. Tack stalls will not be permitted. Burton Complex, by LHSRA directives, can cancel overbooked stall reservations without notice; refunds are not guaranteed and additional fees may apply.
- All horses must be stalled. Tie ups and hitching will not be permitted unless the complex is sold out.
- All walkways between stalls must always be clear. Supplies outside of the horse stalls and in these walkways are not permitted. Burton Complex/LHSRA reserves the right to remove these items at their discretion.
- Contestants are encouraged to bring their own shavings. Fly-Away shavings will be available for purchase on-site through United Ag.
